THE BENDIGO ADD SUPPORT GROUP aims to provide information and support to parents, teachers and health professionals working with children who have ADD/ADAH, or who display challenging behaviours that are not yet diagnosed.


ADD/ADHD are neurological disorders, affecting children and adults. It is not a new condition, but a relatively new name for a set of behavioural characteristics which have been observed and documented since at least the 19th Century.

ADD/ADHD is most commonly observed in children more frequently in boys than in girls, but adults too are affected. Research points to a genetic component.

Jo Gray from Strathdale, Victoria has written 15 pages to us telling of the detailed treatment her son James has received from John Cockfield using the Bowen Technique. There is now absolutely no doubt in my mind that the Bowen Technique has made remarkable changes to James. James has halved his medication, with previously hurried writing, he can, now, calmly write and is amazingly articulate for a child in Year 4.

Jan Stewart of Golden Square, Victoria, who has two boys, Beau 12 years old and Taylor 5 years old, has written 29 pages of detailed treatment on her boys with the Bowen Technique. Beau diagnosed with ADD, and 5 year old Taylor was diagnosed with ADHD, when he was 2 years old.

Watch for - EYES - PUPIL DILATION

- 1. Tiredness wanting to sleep in
- 2. Easier to please willingness to please
- 3. Concentration re school, work, home
- 4. Eating less
- 5. Toilet habits
- 6. Feeling easier walking less clumsy
- 7. Better Balance
- 8. Freedom from pain knees back etc
- 9. Improvement in obnoxious behaviour when visitors are present
- 10. More interest in tasks lower levels of depression

N.B. Treatment was conducted for 4 weeks - followed by a delay of two weeks
