

CODE OF ETHICS

As a Bowenwork[®] student or practitioner, I hereby pledge to abide by the Bowenwork Code of Ethics as outlined below:

Professionalism

- I commit to maintain the highest standard of professional conduct while providing services to my clients and act in a relaxed, friendly, and professional manner with all business associates, health care providers, and the public.
- I commit to professionally represent myself, my business and the Bowenwork profession.
- I shall not abuse the privilege of access to my fellow Bowenwork students' and practitioners' contact information. I shall not mail, email, phone or try to further my own personal interests to my colleagues.
- I am in compliance with all federal, state and local laws requiring business permits, certificates and licenses required to carry out Bowenwork services to clients.
- I will abide by all national, state, and local laws applicable to any license or certificate I hold, as well as by the rules of ethical conduct established by any other applicable governing body.
